1 FAREWELL TO BALFOUR ROAD J32 · 5/5L

Andrew Buxton: RSCDS LII 7 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c+2c Circle4 and back
- 9- 1c+2c Set&Link; 1c+3c Set&Link
- 17- [2c in 1pl start dancing as 1c] 1c+4c+5c Mirror Reels3 on sides, 1c in and down
- 25- 1c in 3pl set | cross down RH to 4plx (4c up); 1c in 4pl set | cross down LH to 5pl (5c up)

Deviser's Note: A new top couple begins every sixteen bars until the original 1st couple reach the top of the set again.

2 MAIRI'S WEDDING R40 · 3/4L

James B Cosh: Twenty Two SCD · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c turn RH | cast (2c up); turn LH to face 1cnrs
- 9- 1c ½Reel4 with 1cnrs (pass P Lsh); Repeat with 2cnrs
- **17–** Repeat with 3cnrs (1cnr person); Repeat with 4cnrs (2cnr person)
- **25-** 1W+2c & 1M+3c Reels3 across, Lsh to 1cnr
- 33- 2c+1c+3c circle6 and back

Note: Cosh explicitly tells 1c to pass Lsh in [9-24]; however the Rsh pass is quite common, and sometimes nicknamed "Mairi's Divorce".

3 12 COATES CRESCENT S32 · 4/4L

RSCDS: RSCDS XL 5 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- All 4 couples set, cross RH; repeat
- 9- 1c & 4c dance NHJ to meet in centre, with person opposite dance NHJ out sides, and cast to own places; 1c lead down to 4pl (2c+3c+4c up on 15–16))
- 17- 3c+4c (middle couples) R&L
- 25- 2c+3c & 4c+1c RHA; LHA

4 EH3 7AF J32 · 3/4L

Roy Goldring: RSCDS XL 6 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c lead down the middle and up, on [8] 2c+3c step in for
- 9- 1c+2c+3c Promenade, at end 1c cast off (to 2,1,3)
- 17- 1c cross Rsh | turn 1cnr RH; cross up/dn Rsh | turn 2cnr RH (2,1x,3)
- 25- 2c+1M & 1W+3c RHA; 1c ½Fig 8 Rsh round 4cnr (2,1,3)

5 TOAST TO THE MOUSIES R32 · 3/4L

Sara Gratiot: RSCDS LIII 13 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c long cast to 2pl (2c up); dance between 3c and cast up (2,1,3)
- 9- 2c+1W & 1M+3c RHA; 2c+1M & 1W+3c LHA, finish 2c in 1pl facing 3c in 3pl, both NHJ, and 1c BtoB in middle, M facing up, W down
- 17- All set | 2c+3c, making arches, dance to meet as 1c dance under, finish 1c (in 1pl/3pl) facing P on midline and 2c+3c BtoB in middle, NHJ; All set | 2c+3c making arches dance to ends, and cast into the reel while{2} 1c dance under arch passing P Lsh and finish between end cpl, facing 1cnr
- 25- 2c+1W & 1M+3c Lsh Reels3(6) across (2c+3c with loops) (to 2,1,3) | All set

Note: after 2nd time through 1c may repeat [1-4] to get to 4pl.

6 INDIAN RIVER STRATHSPEY S32 · 3T

George Senyk: Scottish Country Dances in Diagrams. Ed. 9 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- All in promhold Reel3 across (1c & 3c Rsh to begin).
- 9- With 1W leading, 1c+3c RHA; 1c+2c LHA
- 2c+3c L-Chain **while**{8} 1c set | dance down the middle & cast up round the outside to orig. place.
- **25-** 1c+3c ½R&L; 1c+2c ½R&L. (to 3,1,2)

7 POSTIE'S JIG J32 · 4/4L

Roy Clowes: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c+4c set, cast to middle positions (2c+3c step to end); 1c&4c ½ Fig8 round end C (2,1x,4x,3)
- 9- 1M+4M and 1W+4W cross NHJ, (W under men's arch), turn cnr ¾ with 'free' hand; 1c facing 4c change places NHJ (arch going up), turn cnr as before
- 17- Repeat (Men's arch; arch going up)
- 25- 1c+4c ½ R&L; turn P RH

Note that both times the couple moving UP makes the arch.

8 MISS JOHNSTONE OF ARDROSSAN R32 · 5/5L

Roy Goldring: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two \cdot Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c set | cast off (2c up); 1c followed by 3c dance up and cast round 2c to (2,3,1,4,5)
- 9- 1c+4c+5c mirror Reels3, 1c cross down to enter, 4c start out and up (2,3,1x,4,5)
- 17- 2c+3c+1c mirror Reels3, 1c cross up to enter, 3c start out and down
- 25- 1c set | cast off to 4pl (4c up); 1c followed by 5c dance up and cast round 4c to (2,3,4,5,1)

9 PELORUS JACK J32 · 3/4L

Barry Skelton: RSCDS XLI 1 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross RH, cast (2c up); 1c+3c RHA, finish 1M facing 1cnr, 1W behind him
- 9- 1c in tandem +1cnrs ½ diagonal Reel3, Rsh to 3W (1M & 1W loop R singly for lead change, so 1W now leads P); ½ diagonal Reel3, Rsh to 2W (+ lead change)
- 17- Continue pattern twice
- **25-** 2c+1c LHA; 1c turn LH ½ | all set (2,1,3)

10 THE WIND ON LOCH FYNE S32 · 3T

John Bowie Dickson: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross down, 1W / 1M Figs8 round 2c / 3c (pass between, meet & touch NH, out between same couple, cast up, turn RH ½ to place.
- 9- All C face P for Rsh interlocking Reels4 (acknowledge P on [12], on [16] turn 3/4 RH into:
- 17- Men LHA 2/3 cclw while{2} women dance clw one place | all C turn RH; repeat to new places (2,3,1).
- 25- All C set NHJ | ½ circle6 left; all C turn BH | ½ circle6 left (2,3,1)

11 SHIFTIN' BOBBINS R32 · 3/4L

Roy Clowes: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross down RH (2c up) to 2plx in DTr position with corners | set as DTr; cast up, meet and dance down to 2pl in middle
- 9- 2M+1W+3M RHA, while{4} 2W+1M+3W LHA; 1c followed by 2c+3c dance down the middle
- 17- 3c+2c+1c dance up the middle, 3c casting to 3pl, flowing into; 1W+2M+3M LHA, while{4} 1M+2W+3W RHA
- 25- 1c dance to top, cast off one; ½ Fig8 up round 2c.

12 THE BEES OF MAGGIEKNOCKATER J32 · 4/4L

John Drewry: Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c cross RH | cast off (2c up); 1c+3c RHA, finish as pairs 1M+3W & 3M+1W facing out on W/M side in promhold
- 9- Pairs+ 2c+4c Rsh ½Reels3 on sides; pairs meet & take P in promhold for Lsh ½Reels3 on sides
- 17- Meet and repeat (as pairs Rsh ½Reels3; with P Lsh ½Reels3)
- 25- 1c (passing inside) turn 3c 1½ Easy Hand; 1c cross and passing inside turn 4c EH 1½ (to 2,3,4,1)

13 BALMORAL STRATHSPEY S32 · 4/4L

John A Charles: RSCDS XXII 3 · Crib: E-cribs

- 1- 1c+2c & 3c+4c R&L
- 9- 1c+2c & 3c+4c set | ½ RHA; all set | cross RH (to 2,1,4,3)
- 17- Reels4 on the sides, 2c finish in 1pl, the others dance in on [24] for
- **25** 1c+4c+3c Allemande (to 2,3,4,1)

14 A TRIP TO BAVARIA R32 · 4/4L

James MacGregor-Brown: Collins Pocket Reference: Scottish Country Dancing · Crib: E-cribs

- 1-16 1c+4c cross RH while 2c+3c ½RHA | middle and end Cs change place LH on sides ; repeat 3 times, finish (1,2,3,4) 1c facing 2c
 - 17- 1c set to 2c | cross down to face 3c (2c dance up); 1c+3c repeat
 - **25-** 1c+4c repeat ; All A&R, 1c changing sides RH on [30] (2,3,4,1)

Note: on [30] the original says "RH", but "BH" is widely used.
